PLACE: Seitzland Rifle Club, 3938 Bowser Road, New Freedom, Pennsylvania.

DIRECTIONS: Exit # 4 off I-83 to PA Route 851 through Shrewsbury, through New Freedom, to Bowser Road just outside New Freedom. West two miles, look for a sign on the tree to the right.

Breakfast and lunch will be available for purchase at the range. We have 30 covered firing points on concrete.

TIME: The first relay will be firing at 8:30 A.M., both days.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all individuals.

CLASSIFICATIONS: NRA classification will be used. Rule 19.6, Assigned Classification, or Rule 19.2, Temporary Classification will apply. Juniors may, if they wish, shoot for score only (no awards). Classes and categories that have enough entries (5) to stand alone will do so, while others will be combined for awards.

CATEGORIES: Civilian and Junior categories only.

RULES: Current NRA rules will apply.

SQUADDING: Competitors will be assigned on firing point for the entire tournament. Like classifications will be grouped when possible.

FEES: \$70 for both days, \$45 for one day. Juniors or unclassified shooters may fire for score only, NO AWARDS, \$30 for one day or \$40 for both days.

AWARDS: Cash equal to more than 50% of entry fee to 20% of shooters. Each match will have a winner plus a winner in each class.

SCORING: Challenges will be \$2.00. Ties will be broken by rule 15.7.

COMPETITOR RESPONSIBILITY: It is the responsibility of the competitor to arrive at the range sufficiently in advance of the scheduled firing time (approximately 1 hour) to check in with the statistical office and to prepare for firing. Competitors who fail to report to the firing line when their relay is called may, at the discretion of the Match Director, forfeit the right to fire in the match.

Practice: The range will open at noon Friday, May 17, June 20 and September 19, for 50 and 100 yard practice.

COURSE OF FIRE:

Matches 1 & 6 – 40 shots at 50 yards, A-23 target
Matches 2 & 7 – 40 shots at 50 meters, A-27 target
Matches 3 & 8 – 40 shots Dewar course, A-23 and A-25 targets
Matches 4 & 9 – 40 shots at 100 yards, A-25 target

Matches 1,2,3,4 are fired on Saturday with metallic sights.
Matches 6,7,8,9 are fired on Sunday with any sights.

Match 5 – Metallic sights, total of Matches 1, 2,3, and 4
Match 10 – Any sights, total of Matches 6, 7, 8, and 9
Match 11 – Grand Aggregate, total of Matches 5 & 10
